BY-LAW 1077-2023

To authorize the alteration of Eastgate Crescent, between Pharmacy Avenue and St. Clair Avenue East, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Scarborough Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Eastgate Crescent, between Pharmacy Avenue and St. Clair Avenue East, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy.

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

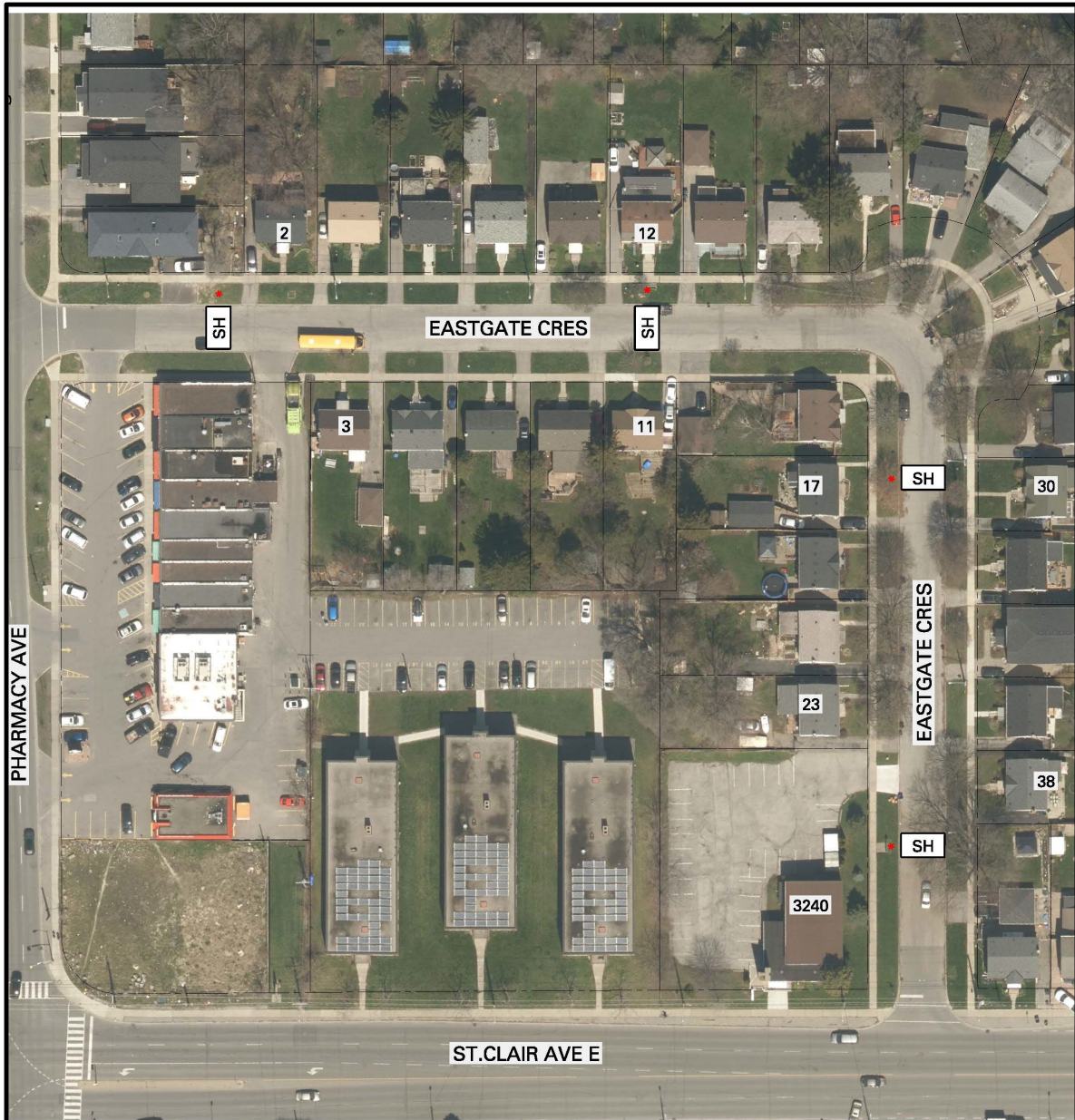


