BY-LAW 1089-2023

To authorize the naming of a proposed public street, located between Keating Channel and Commissioners Street, as New Cherry Street.

Whereas the Council of the City of Toronto has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public street; and

Whereas the Council of the City of Toronto intends to provide an interim name to the street that will be replaced by a permanent name at a future date;

and shown as PART 2 on Sketch No. PS-2023-033 attached to this By-law is named New Cherry Street.

2. Section 1 of this By-law shall take effect on the date that Section 1 of By-law 1088-2023 is in effect.
