BY-LAW 1100-2023

To amend By-law 412-2023, being a by-law to authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of a municipal capital facility used to provide social and health services located at 800 Lansdowne Avenue, Suite 101, Building C, and its exemption from taxation for municipal and school purposes and to make a technical amendment to name the tenant, South Asian Women's Centre, together with the City, as the parties to the municipal capital facility agreement, to make a technical amendment.

Whereas Council wishes to amend By-law 412-2023 and the Municipal Capital Facility Agreement dated June 15, 2023, which was authorized by that By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 413-2023 is amended by replacing the reference to "Assessment Roll No. 1904-07-1-160-03407" in Schedule A with "Assessment Roll No. 1904 031 520 00152".
2. The City of Toronto is authorized to enter into an amended Municipal Capital Facility Agreement between the South Asian Women's Centre, the tenant, which leases 800 Lansdowne Avenue, Suite 100 Building C from the City of Toronto, used for social and health services.
