BY-LAW 1124-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bloor Street West.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule VI (Commercial Loading Zones) in § 950-1305, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West	South	A point 39 metres west of Durie Street to a point 15 metres further west	Anytime for a maximum period of 30 minutes

- B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West	South	A point 39 metres west of Durie Street and a point 67 metres east of Windermere Avenue	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West	South	A point 54 metres west of Durie Street and a point 67 metres east of Windermere Avenue	Anytime
