## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 1125-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting King Street West, Queen Street West, Roncesvalles Avenue, Sunnyside Avenue and The Queensway.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule III (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) in § 950-1302, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Location)
The Queensway	Between the west curb line of Glendale Avenue and a point 30.5 metres west

B. By inserting in Schedule III (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) in § 950-1302, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Location)
The Queensway	Between a point 30.5 metres west of west curb line of Sunnyside Avenue and a point 30.5 metres east of east curb line of Sunnyside Avenue

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Queen Street West	South	Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 67.2 metres further east	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Roncesvalles Avenue	East	Queen Street West and Grafton Avenue	Anytime
Roncesvalles Avenue	West	Queen Street West and Grafton Avenue	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
The Queensway	King Street West and a point 30.5 metres west	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning

E. By inserting in Schedule XXII (Reserved Lanes For Designated Classes of Vehicles) in § 950-1321, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Designated Class of Vehicle)
The Queensway	Claude Avenue and Roncesvalles Avenue/King Street	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime	PTVs and Toronto Transit Commission Vehicles

F. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
The Queensway and Roncesvalles Avenue/King Street West/Queen Street West	Eastbound	Left	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (streetcars excepted)

G. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
The Queensway and Claude Avenue	Southbound	Left	Anytime
The Queensway and Sunnyside Avenue	Westbound	U-turns	Anytime

H. By deleting from Schedule XI (Safety Zones) in § 950-1310, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Location)
The Queensway	North side, immediately east of Glendale Avenue
The Queensway	South side, immediately east of Glendale Avenue
The Queensway	South side, immediately west of Roncesvalles Avenue

I. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection/Location)
The Queensway and Sunnyside Avenue
