BY-LAW 1134-2023

To dedicate certain lands along a lane east of George Street between Glenholme Place and the lane north of Dundas Street for public lane purposes.

Whereas the City is the owner of certain lands acquired for public lane purposes;

PART OF THE PUBLIC LANE ABUTTING THE NORTHERLY LIMIT OF
LOT 19, REGISTERED PLAN 150, KNOWN AS GLENHOLME PLACE,
CLOSED BY BYLAW 13-2002 (INSTRUMENT CA762226)
DESIGNATED AS PART 1, PLAN 64R-17100

is dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane Glenholme Place and the lane north of Dundas Street, east of George Street, respectively.
