BY-LAW 1139-2023

To appoint Interim Deputy City Managers, Corporate Services.

Whereas under section 226.3, 226.4(1) and 226.4(2) of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the Mayor may appoint a chief administrative officer, may hire and dismiss a head of any division or the head of any other part of the City's organizational structure, and may determine the organizational structure of the City; and

Whereas the authority to appoint Deputy City Managers was delegated to City Council by Mayoral Decision 6-2023;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. For the period commencing on December 4, 2023 and ending on December 31, 2023, David Jollimore is appointed Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services and shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager as may be assigned by the City Manager or Council from time to time.
2. For the period commencing on January 1, 2024 and ending on January 28, 2024, Patrick Matozzo is appointed Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services and shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager as may be assigned by the City Manager or Council from time to time.
3. For the period commencing on January 29, 2024 and ending on February 25, 2024, David Jollimore is appointed Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services and shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager as may be assigned by the City Manager or Council from time to time.
4. For the period commencing on February 26, 2024 and ending on March 24, 2024, Patrick Matozzo is appointed Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services and shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager as may be assigned by the City Manager or Council from time to time.
5. Sections 1 and 3 of this by-law come into effect on the latter of the earliest date set out in each of those sections or the date on which David Jollimore has agreed to temporary terms and conditions of his employment offered by the City for the position of Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services position.
6. Sections 2 and 4 of this by-law come into effect on the latter of the earliest date set out in each of those sections or the date on which Patrick Matozzo has agreed to temporary

terms and conditions of his employment offered by the City for the position of Interim Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services position.
