CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1171-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Strathburn Boulevard.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Strathburn Boulevard	West	A point 48 metres south of Wallasey Avenue and a point 30 metres further south	Anytime
Strathburn Boulevard	West	A point 117 metres south of Wallasey Avenue and a point 20 metres further south	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Strathburn Boulevard	West	A point 137 metres south of Wallasey Avenue and a point 13 metres further south	Anytime, Mon. to Fri.

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Strathburn Boulevard	West	A point 48 metres south of Wallasey Avenue and a point 150 metres further south	Anytime

D. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Strathburn Boulevard	West	A point 78 metres south of Wallasey Avenue and a point 39 metres further south	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	15 mins.
