BY-LAW 1182-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting St. Clements Avenue.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

St. Clements Avenue	North	Duplex Avenue and a point 84 metres east	7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.
St. Clements Avenue	North	Duplex Avenue and a point 84 metres east	9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat. and Sun.	1 hour

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
St. Clements Avenue	North	Duplex Avenue and a point 84 metres east	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	1 hour
