BY-LAW 8-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Aileen Avenue, Batavia Avenue and Mildred Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Batavia Avenue	East	A point 94.7 metres south of Pritchard Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive and from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive
Batavia Avenue	West	A point 98.6 metres south of Pritchard Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime from the 1st day to the 15 th day of year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive

B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Aileen Avenue	North	A point 40 metres west of Scott Road and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Mildred Avenue	West	A point 49 metres north of Bernice Crescent Road and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
