BY-LAW 26-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Concord Avenue and Hallam Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Concord Avenue and Hallam Street
