BY-LAW 32-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Sammon Avenue and Woodington Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)
Sammon Avenue	The east side of Coxwell Avenue and the west side of Glebemount Avenue

B. By inserting in Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)
Sammon Avenue	The east side of Coxwell Avenue and the west side of Woodington Avenue
Sammon Avenue	The east side of Woodington Avenue and the west side of Glebemount Avenue

C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Sammon Avenue and Woodington Avenue	Sammon Avenue
Woodington Avenue and Sammon Avenue	Woodington Avenue
