BY-LAW 48-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Sammon Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Sammon Avenue	North	A point 46 metres west of Coxwell Avenue and a point 63 metres further west	9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
Sammon Avenue	North	Coxwell Avenue and a point 46 metres west	Anytime

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- B. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Sammon Avenue	North	Durant Avenue and Coxwell Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays	15 mins.

- C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Sammon Avenue	North	A point 46 metres west of Coxwell Avenue and a point 63 metres further west	8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays	15 mins.
