BY-LAW 89-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Taymall Avenue and The Queensway.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Taymall Avenue	East	The Queensway and Queen Elizabeth Boulevard	Anytime
Taymall Avenue	West	A point 190 metres north of Queen Elizabeth Boulevard and The Queensway	Anytime
The Queensway	South	A point 29.5 metres east of Plastics Avenue and Royal York Road	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Taymall Avenue	East	Queen Elizabeth Boulevard and a point 79 metres south of The Queensway	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Taymall Avenue	West	A point 190 metres north of Queen Elizabeth Boulevard and a point 79 metres south of The Queensway	Anytime
The Queensway	South	A point 29.5 metres east of Plastics Avenue and Taymall Avenue	Anytime
The Queensway	South	A point 68 metres east of Taymall Avenue and Royal York Road	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Taymall Avenue	Both	The Queensway and a point 79 metres south	Anytime
The Queensway	South	Taymall Avenue and a point 68 metres east	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection/Location)

The Queensway and a point 125 metres east of Taymall Avenue
