BY-LAW 93-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Bloor Street West and Perth Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West and Perth Avenue	Eastbound	Left	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri. (bicycles excepted)
Bloor Street West and Perth Avenue	Northbound	Left	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West and Perth Avenue	All Directions	Left	Anytime (bicycles excepted)
Perth Avenue and Bloor Street West	Northbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
Perth Avenue and Bloor Street West	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(In Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(In Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Bloor Street West	Perth Avenue, north of Bloor Street West	Perth Avenue, south of Bloor Street West
Bloor Street West	Perth Avenue, south of Bloor Street West	Perth Avenue, north of Bloor Street West
