BY-LAW 386-2024

To permanently close a portion of an unused portion of Eglinton Avenue West, west of Croham Road.

Whereas it is recommended that the public highway known as the unused portion of Eglinton Avenue West Allowance, located at the west of Croham Road described as Part of the Road Allowance Between Concession 3, West of Yonge Street and Concession 3, From the Bay (Closed by By-law No. 10823), Geographic Township of York, City of Toronto, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-31588 be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 162 and the General Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on March 26, 2024;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway known as the unused portion of Eglinton Avenue West Allowance, located at the west of Croham Road and described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 104910522

Being that part of the Road Allowance Between Concession 3, West of Yonge Street and Concession 3, From the Bay (Closed by By-law No. 10823), Geographic Township of York, City of Toronto, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-31588.
