BY-LAW 399-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting St. Clair Avenue West and Winona Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Winona Drive	St. Clair Avenue West and Barrie Avenue	2 Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound
Winona Drive	St. Clair Avenue West and Barrie Avenue	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound (bicycles only)

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
St. Clair Avenue West and Winona Drive	Eastbound	Left	Anytime (bicycles excepted)
St. Clair Avenue West and Winona Drive	Westbound	Right	Anytime (bicycles excepted)
Winona Drive and St. Clair Avenue West	Northbound	Through	Anytime (bicycles excepted)

C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
