## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 482-2024**

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Lake Shore Boulevard West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
  - A.** By inserting in Schedule XXII (Reserved Lanes For Designated Classes of Vehicles) in § 950-1321, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Designated Class of Vehicle)
Lake Shore Boulevard West	A point approximately 70 metres west of Yonge Street and a point 55 metres further west	Northerly Westbound	Anytime	PTVs
