CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 518-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Glenforest Road, Livingstone Avenue, Parliament Street, Queen Street East and Roseheath Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Highway) | (From Column 2 Side) | (From Column 3 Between) | (From Column 4 Times and/or Days) | (From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted) |
|-------------------------------|----------------------------|---|--|--|
| Glenforest Road | North | Yonge Street and a point 35 metres east of Yonge Street | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat. | 1 hour |
| Livingstone Avenue | South | Dufferin Street and a point 60 metres east | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat., except public holidays | 2 hours |
| Parliament Street | Both | Adelaide Street East and Queen Street East | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. | 1 hour |
| Queen Street East | South | Sherbourne Street and a point 93 metres west of Sackville Street | 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sat. | 1 hour |
| Roseheath Avenue | West | Stacy Street and Danforth Avenue | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. | 1 hour |

B. By inserting Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Times and/or Days) | (In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted) |
|-----------------------------|--------------------------|--|--|--|
| Roseheath Avenue | West | Stacy Street and a point 31 metres south of Danforth Avenue | 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. | 1 hour |
