BY-LAW 560-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Defries Street and Mark Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Defries Street	East	A point 52 metres south of Market Street and Labatt Avenue	Anytime
Defries Street	East	Mark Street and a point 20 metres south	Anytime
Mark Street	South	Defries Street and the east end of Mark Street	Anytime

- B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Defries Street	East	Labatt Avenue and Mark Street	Anytime
Mark Street	South	A point 15 metres west of Defries Street and the east end of Mark Street	Anytime

C. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Mark Street	South	River Street and a point 15 metres west	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	1 hour

D. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Mark Street	South	River Street and Defries Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	1 hour
