The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, the City Clerk and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the City's seal to the documents.
3. This By-law, to the extent to which it provides authority for or constitutes the exercise by the Council of its powers to proceed with, or to provide any money for, any undertaking, work, project, scheme, act, matter or thing which requires an approval in addition to the approval of the Council, shall not take effect until the additional approval has been obtained.
4. For the purposes of the exercise of the authority of the head of council to veto a by-law in accordance with section 226.9 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, this Confirmatory By-law shall be deemed to be separate Confirmatory By-laws for each item listed on the agenda.
