- B. By inserting in Schedule XXII (Reserved Lanes For Designated Classes of Vehicles) in § 950-1321, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

The Esplanade	Lower Sherbourne Street and a point 50 metres east	Northerly westbound	Anytime	PTVs
The Esplanade	Lower Sherbourne Street and a point 50 metres east	Eastbound lane adjacent to the northerly westbound curb lane	Anytime	PTVs
