## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 696-2024

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Avenue Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:
