BY-LAW 823-2024

To make a technical amendment to by-law 576-2022 with respect to the remedial action provisions under Article 8 of Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition.

Whereas Section 169-5.2 of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, permits the City Solicitor to submit bills directly to Council to make technical and other amendments; and

Whereas § 363-8.5B of by-law 576-2022 is being amended to accurately reflect the remedial action cost recovery provisions adopted by Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 363-8.5B of by-law 576-2022 is deleted and replaced as follows:
 - B. Under section 386 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may recover the costs of doing it by action, or the costs may be added to the tax roll and collected in the same manner as property taxes.
2. This by-law is deemed to have come into force on June 16, 2022.
