BY-LAW 849-2024

To amend Subsection 950-901B(1) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking.

Whereas pursuant to section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization; and

Whereas pursuant to section 169-5.2F of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor is authorized to make to any stylistic and/or technical changes to the bills or by-laws submitted to the City Clerk for processing, including any bills or by-laws enacted by Council, any delegated by-laws to Committees of Council, and any delegated by-laws enacted by a specified City Official;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended by deleting from § 950-901B(1) the phrase “, circular amber or amber arrow indication,”.
