BY-LAW 1035-2024

To assume municipal services located in and on the streets on 66M-2533.

Whereas the City has entered into a Subdivision Agreement with 3600 Lakeshore GP Inc., Minto 3600 Lakeshore Commercial Inc. and Stockton 3600 Lakeshore GP Inc., to provide for the public highways and municipal services on Plan 66M-2533 and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City of Toronto's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Subdivision Agreement;
