## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 1047-2024**

#### **To appoint an Interim Fire Chief and General Manager, Toronto Fire Services.**

Whereas under subsection 6(1) of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c. 4, as amended, the Council of a municipality in which a fire department is established shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department; and

Whereas under § 79-2 and § 79-3 of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Council has established the Fire Services Division to serve as the fire department under the direction of the Fire Chief to provide fire protection services for the City; and

Whereas under § 79-1 of the Municipal Code, the Fire Chief shall be appointed by Council on the recommendation of the City Manager;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Larry Cocco is appointed Interim Fire Chief and General Manager of Toronto Fire Services, effective immediately and until such time as a Fire Chief and General Manager of Toronto Fire Services has been appointed.
2. Upon appointment as the Interim Fire Chief and General Manager of Toronto Fire Services pursuant to section 1, Larry Cocco shall have, in addition to any powers, rights and duties assigned to a fire chief under Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c. 4, as amended, or by any other statute or by-law of the City, all the responsibilities and authority of the Fire Chief under Chapter 79, Fire Services, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
3. On the date this by-law comes into force, By-law 478-2017 is repealed.
