BY-LAW 1080-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Lower Spadina and Queens Quay West.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Lower Spadina and Queens Quay West	Queens Quay West and a point 30.5 metres north	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Lower Spadina and Queens Quay West	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
