CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1378-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting King Street West.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule V (Stands for Taxicabs) in § 950-1304, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Location)	(From Column 4 Number of Taxicabs)	(From Column 5 Times and/or Days)
King Street West	South	Between a point 72.3 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 37.2 metres further east	6	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule V (Stands for Taxicabs) in § 950-1304, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Number of Taxicabs)	(In Column 5 Times and/or Days)
King Street West	South	Between a point 77.8 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 31.7 metres further east	5	Anytime

C. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
King Street West	South	A point 40.5 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 31.8 metres further east	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
King Street West	South	A point 40.5 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 37.3 metres further east	Anytime
