BY-LAW 1415-2024

To permanently close the portion of the public highway known as Borough Drive, Toronto, between Triton Road and Progress Avenue.

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known as Borough Drive, Toronto be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on June 30, 2022;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The portion of Borough Drive, between Triton Road and Progress Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

PART OF PIN 06000-0208(LT)
PART OF BOROUGH DRIVE, PLAN 66M-1410 AND
PART OF BLOCK RX, PLAN 66M-1410 (1 FOOT RESERVE, DEDICATED
BY BY-LAW NO. 15752, INSTRUMENT NO. A832669)
DESIGNATED AS PART 13, PLAN 66R-34390
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until such time as the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer by the City of Toronto as transferor, of the land described in Section 1 of this By-law.
