BY-LAW 1427-2024

To dedicate certain lands along Sheppard Avenue East east of Reidmount Avenue for public highway purposes.

Whereas certain City Lands will be transferred to Metrolinx in support of the Agincourt GO Station and in exchange Metrolinx will transfer the certain lands to the City for dedication as a public highway;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Certain land described as follows:

PART OF 06104-0302 (LT)
PART OF LOT 28, CONCESSION 3
GEOGRAPHIC TOWNSHIP OF SCARBOROUGH
DESIGNATED AS PART 1, PLAN 66R-33287
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Sheppard Avenue East.

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until such time as the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer to the City of Toronto of the land described in Section 1 of this By-law.
