## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 1428-2024**

#### **To permanently close a portion of Agincourt Drive from Sheppard Avenue East to approximately 30m north of Sheppard Avenue East.**

Whereas it is recommended that that portion of public highway known as Agincourt Drive, located from Sheppard Avenue East to approximately 30m north of Sheppard Avenue East, be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, and the Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on December 6, 2024;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The portion of the public highway known as Agincourt Drive, located from Sheppard Avenue East to approximately 30m north of Sheppard Avenue East, and described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

PART OF PIN 06098-0074 (LT)  
PART OF AGINCOURT DRIVE  
(FORMERLY KNOWN AS FIRST AVENUE)  
REGISTERED PLAN 1909  
DESIGNATED AS PARTS 1 & 2, PLAN 66R-33288  
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario  
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not take effect until the moment in time immediately prior to the registration in the appropriate land registry office of a Transfer, by the City of Toronto as transferor, of the land described in Section 1 of this By-law.
