BY-LAW 1433-2024

To dedicate certain lands located at the northwest quadrant of Eglinton Avenue East and Midland Avenue for temporary public highway purposes.

Whereas the City anticipates it will be granted a lease or an assignment of an easement or transfer of easement for temporary public highway purposes from Metrolinx or other such party pursuant to an instrument registered on title in the Land Registry Office for Toronto (No. 66);

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Certain land described as follows:

PART OF PIN 06348-0477 (LT)
PART OF BLOCK A, REGISTERED PLAN M-680
DESIGNATED AS PARTS 1, 4, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13 & 14, PLAN 66R-33351
PART OF PIN 06348-0476 (LT)
PART OF BLOCK A, REGISTERED PLAN M-680
DESIGNATED AS PARTS 2 & 3, PLAN 66R-33351
City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Eglinton Avenue East.

2. Section 1 does not come into effect until the date that there is registered on title to the subject property a notice of lease, assignment or transfer of an easement in favour of the City for all those lands described in Section 1 from the registered owner of such lands or the easement holder.
