BY-LAW 90-2025

To dedicate certain lands along Cherry Street, located between Commissioners Street and Polson Street, for public highway purposes.

Whereas as part of the Port Lands Flood Protection and Enabling Infrastructure Project, part of Cherry Street is being realigned to the west of its current location; and

Whereas the Toronto Economic Development Corporation ("TEDCO") owns most of the lands involved in the realignment; and

Whereas the City is negotiating the terms of transfer of the TEDCO lands to the City in fee simple;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Certain land described as follows:

DESIGNATED AS PARTS 64 & 65, PLAN 66R-32609

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

are dedicated for public highway purposes.

2. Section 1 of this by-law does not come into effect until the date that the last of the interests in land in Section 1 are conveyed to the City.
