CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 216-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Blackthorn Avenue, Rockwell Avenue and Silverthorn Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Blackthorn Avenue	Rogers Road and Rockwell Avenue	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Silverthorn Avenue	A point 32 metres north of Rogers Road and a point 32 metres south of Rowntree Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Silverthorn Avenue	A point 32 metres south of Rowntree Avenue and Turnberry Avenue	Southbound adjacent to curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Silverthorn Avenue	Rockwell Avenue and a point 37 metres north of St. Clair Avenue West	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Silverthorn Avenue	Turnberry Avenue and Rockwell Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Rockwell Avenue	Silverthorn Avenue (west intersection) and Silverthorn Avenue (east intersection)	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
