BY-LAW 376-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Shinleaf Terrace and William Sylvester Drive.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Shinleaf Terrace	Both	William Sylvester Drive and Yorkland Boulevard	Anytime
William Sylvester Drive	Both	Shinleaf Terrace and a point 30.5 metres west of Consumers Road	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Shinleaf Terrace	Both	William Sylvester Drive and Yorkland Boulevard	Anytime

- C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Shinleaf Terrace and Yorkland Boulevard	Shinleaf Terrace
Shinleaf Terrace and William Sylvester Drive	Shinleaf Terrace
William Sylvester Drive and Shinleaf Terrace	William Sylvester Drive

- D. By deleting from Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Intersection/Location)
Consumer Road and a point 90 metres south of Yorkland Boulevard / Private Access
