BY-LAW 482-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Jimmy Wisdom Way.

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Jimmy Wisdom Way	A point 30.5 metres north of Eglinton Avenue West and Belgravia Avenue	Easterly northbound adjacent to curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Jimmy Wisdom Way	A point 30.5 metres north of Eglinton Avenue West and Hopewell Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
