AMENDMENT 822 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN

LANDS MUNICIPALLY KNOWN IN THE YEAR 2024 AS 13, 15, 17, 19 and 21 JOHN STREET and 40 SOUTH STATION STREET

The Official Plan of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- 1. Chapter 7, Site and Area Specific Policies, Site and Area Specific Policy 45 is amended for lands known municipally in 2024 as 13, 15, 17, 19 and 21 John Street and 40 South Station Street by adding subsection a) ii) as follows:
 - "a) ii) On the lands known as 13, 15, 17, 19 and 21 John Street and 40 South Station Street:

A new building will be limited to a height of 137 metres not including the mechanical penthouse."
