## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 601-2025**

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Eglinton Avenue West and Northcliffe Boulevard.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in  
alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Northcliffe Boulevard	East	Vaughan Road and Eglinton Avenue West	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

B. By deleting from Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in  
alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(From Column 4 Direction)
Northcliffe Boulevard	Rogers Road and Eglinton Avenue West	Anytime	Northbound

C. By inserting in Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in  
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 4 Direction)
Northcliffe Boulevard	Rogers Road and Vaughan Road	Anytime	Northbound

D. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Eglinton Avenue West	Bicknell Avenue and a point 68 metres further west	Southerly eastbound adjacent to curb lane used for cycling	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning (T.T.C. buses excepted)
Eglinton Avenue West	Dufferin Street and a point 44 metres further east	Northerly westbound adjacent to curb lane used for cycling	Anytime	Westbound right-turning (T.T.C. buses excepted)
