BY-LAW 812-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting King Street East.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule VI (Commercial Loading Zones) in § 950-1305, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
King Street East	South	Between a point 46 metres east of Trinity Street and a point 7 metres further east	Anytime, except 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
King Street East	South	Parliament Street and Queen Street East	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
King Street East	South	A point 53 metres east of Trinity Street and a point 15 metres further east	Anytime
King Street East	South	A point 68 east of Trinity Street and Queen Street East	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except public holidays
King Street East	South	Parliament Street and a point 53 metres east of Trinity Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except public holidays
