BY-LAW 969-2025

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Berner Trail, Malvern Street and Mammoth Hall Trail.**

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A.** By deleting from Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334,
the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Speed Limit (km/h))
Berner Trail	Neilson Road and Washburn Way	40
Malvern Street	McLevin Avenue and Sheppard Avenue East	40
Mammoth Hall Trail	Malvern Street and Washburn Way	40

- B. By deleting from Schedule XLV (Part 1): Designated Areas – Reduced Speed Areas in § 950-1344, the following in alphabetical order by designated area name:

(From Column 1 Designated Area Name)	(From Column 2 East Limit/West Limit of Designated Area)	(From Column 3 North Limit/South Limit of Designated Area)	(From Column 4 Excluded Highways or Bridges)	(From Column 5 Speed (km/h))	(From Column 6 Designated Area Map)
(Area 11) in Ward 23	West side of Neilson Road / east side of Markham Road	South side of McLevin Avenue between Markham Road and Tapscott Road and south side of Tapscott Road between McLevin Avenue and Neilson Road / north side of Sheppard Avenue East	Berner Trail between Neilson Road and Washburn Way Malvern Street between Sheppard Avenue East and McLevin Avenue Mammoth Hall Trail between Washburn Way and Malvern Street	30	(Area 11) in Ward 23
