BY-LAW 1123-2025

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Galloway Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes,
and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical
order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Galloway Road	Guildwood Parkway and Dearham Wood	Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound	Anytime
