## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 1171-2025**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting The Esplanade.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
  - A.** By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
The Esplanade	Scott Street and Market Street	Southerly westbound lane adjacent to the southerly eastbound cycle track	Anytime
The Esplanade	Scott Street and Market Street	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
