BY-LAW 1272-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Dalhousie Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Dalhousie Street	East	A point 9 metres north of Dundas Street East and a point 11 metres further north	Anytime

- B. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Dalhousie Street	East	A point 9 metres north of Dundas Street East and a point 11 metres further north	Anytime	15 mins.

- C. By deleting from Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(From Column 4 Direction)
Dalhousie Street	A point 54 metres north of Dundas Street East and Gould Street	Anytime	Northbound

- D. By inserting in Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 4 Direction)
Dalhousie Street	Dundas Street East and Gould Street	Anytime	Northbound

- E. By deleting from Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection)	(From Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Dalhousie Street and Dundas Street East	Dalhousie Street
