CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1393-2025

To authorize the exemption from taxation for municipal and school purposes for the municipal capital facility for affordable housing located at 1117 Danforth Avenue.

Whereas section 252 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 provides that the City may exempt from taxation for municipal and school purposes land or a portion of it on which municipal capital facilities are, or will be, located and an agreement for municipal capital facilities may allow for the lease, operation or maintenance of the facilities;

Whereas paragraph 18 of subsection 2(1) of Ontario Regulation 598/06 prescribes municipal facilities used for affordable housing for the purpose of section 252 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006;

Whereas subsection 7(1) of Ontario Regulation 598/06 requires that in respect of municipal facilities used for housing, the housing units fall within the definition of "affordable housing" as the term is defined in the City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 513, Housing Programs ("Chapter 513");

Whereas 1117 Danforth Development NP has agreed to provide affordable housing at the property currently known as 1117 Danforth Avenue, Toronto;

Whereas the portions of the Premises identified in Schedule A hereto are primarily used for affordable housing (the "Eligible Premises"); and

Whereas Council has entered into an agreement with 1117 Danforth Development NP for the provision of municipal capital facilities for use as affordable housing at the Eligible Premises, and for the provision of an exemption from taxation for municipal and school purposes to the Eligible Premises (the "Agreement");

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. The Eligible Premises are exempt from taxation for municipal and school purposes.**

2. The tax exemptions referred to herein shall be effective, in accordance with Chapter 513, from the date of execution of the municipal housing facility agreement, the date this by-law is enacted, or the date and amending agreement is signed, whichever is later, and shall continue during the period of construction and during the 99 year affordability period thereafter.
3. This by-law shall be deemed repealed:
 - (a) if 1117 Danforth Development NP ceases to occupy the Eligible Premises without having assigned the Agreement to a person approved by the City in accordance with the Agreement;
 - (b) if 1117 Danforth Development NP or its successor in law ceases to use the Eligible Premises for the purposes of affordable housing in accordance with Chapter 513 and the Agreement; and/or
 - (c) if the Agreement is terminated for any reason whatsoever.

Construction and operation of a building containing 108 newly constructed units of which up to 67 units will be affordable rental housing units and up to 41 units will be rent-controlled housing units or such other number of units as approved by the City at 1117 Danforth Avenue, Toronto.
