BY-LAW 1398-2025

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 179, Parking Authority, to amend the composition of the Parking Authority.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 179, Parking Authority, is amended by:

A. Deleting subsections § 179-1 A, B and C and adding a new subsection to § 179-1 as follows:

The Parking Authority shall consist of:

(1) the following five City officials appointed by virtue of office:

- (a) City Manager, as Chair;
- (b) Chief Financial Officer;
- (c) Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services;
- (d) Executive Director, Environment, Climate and Forestry Division;
and
- (e) General Manager, Transportation Services.

B. Deleting subsection § 179-2.

C. Deleting the paragraph in § 179-3 and adding a new subsection to § 179-3 as follows:

The members will not be paid any remuneration for serving on the Parking Authority.

D. Deleting § 179-4, § 179-5 and § 179-6.

2. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed.
