BY-LAW 1463-2025

To assume municipal services located in and on the streets on 66M-2503.

Whereas the City has entered into a Subdivision Agreement with Damaris Developments Inc., to provide for the public highways and municipal services on Plan 66M-2503 and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City of Toronto's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Subdivision Agreement;
