BY-LAW 1552-2025

To appoint Kamal Gogna as Chief Building Official and Executive Director, Toronto Building, for the City of Toronto and to revoke the appointment of William Johnston as Chief Building Official.

Whereas subsection 3(2) of the *Building Code Act, 1992*, S.O. 1992, c. 23, as amended, requires council of each municipality to appoint a Chief Building Official; and

Whereas under section 77 of the *Legislation Act, 2006*, S.O.2006, c.21, as amended, the power to appoint a person to a public office includes the power to remove the person; and

Whereas City Council previously appointed William Johnston as Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto; and

Whereas City Council wishes to appoint Kamal Gogna as Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 1 of By-law 389-2019 is amended by replacing that section with the following new Section 1:
 1. Kamal Gogna is appointed Chief Building Official and Executive Director, Toronto Building for the City of Toronto effective January 1, 2026.
2. By-law 339-2018 is repealed;
3. This by-law comes into effect on the latter of January 1, 2026 or the date on which Kamal Gogna has entered into a written employment agreement with the City for the Chief Building Official and Executive Director, Toronto Building position.
