## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 56-2026

**To extend the hours of sale and service of liquor by holders of a licence under the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019 in the morning during the XXV Olympic Winter Games, Milano Cortina 2026.**

Whereas under subsection 79(1) of the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, the City may pass by-laws extending the hours of sale of liquor in all or part of the City by the holders of a licence and a by-law may authorize a specified officer or employee of the City to extend the hours of sale during events of municipal, provincial, national or international significance; and

Whereas under subsection 79(3) of the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, this by-law does not prevail over a condition of a licence or permit; and

Whereas the XXV Olympic Winter Games will be held in Milano Cortina on February 4 to February 22, 2026; and

Whereas Council wishes to extend the hours of sale of liquor in the City on certain dates during the XXV Olympic Winter Games;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. In the City of Toronto on February 5 to 22, 2026, inclusive, liquor may be sold by the holders of a licence under the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019 beginning at 6:00 a.m.
