BY-LAW 161-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting the Public Lane South of Queen Street, West of Simcoe Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

- 1.** Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A.** By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
First public lane south of Queen Street, west of Simcoe Street	Both	A point 60 metres east of Duncan Street and a point 15 metres further east	Anytime
First public lane south of Queen Street, west of Simcoe Street	Both	A point 108 metres east of Duncan Street and Simcoe Street	Anytime
First public lane south of Queen Street, west of Simcoe Street	Both	Duncan Street and a point 43 metres east	Anytime
